### **THROUGHOUT THE ARCHDIOCESE, TODAY IS LEADERSHIP 100 SUNDAY**

Leadership 100 has now reached a milestone of 1,000 members from a broad spectrum of Greek Orthodox leaders, men and women of all ages from every field of endeavor, including young professionals. Over the 33 years since its founding, Leadership 100 has distributed over to \$46 million in grants to support the National Ministries and institutions of the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America and the Metropolises, advancing Orthodoxy and Hellenism and meeting human need in the nation and around the world.

Leadership 100 grants range from providing scholarship funds for individuals studying for the priesthood at Hellenic College/Holy Cross School of Theology, to supporting a variety of National Ministries that include Religious and Greek Education, Youth, Young Adult, Family and Marriage services, Inter-Orthodox, Ecumenical and Interfaith Relations, Internet Ministries and Home Mission, as well as humanitarian assistance during national and international crises.

We are thrilled that two of our parishioners, Ms. Paulette Poulos (Executive Director) and Mr. George Tsandikos (Chairman), are leading this incredibly vital ministry of our Church. May God continue to bless them and all of the members of Leadership 100.

## SCRIPTURE READINGS

Τῷ δὲ βασιλεῖ τῶν αἰώνων, ἀφθάρτῳ, ἀοράτῳ, μόνῳ σοφῷ θεῷ, τιμὴ καὶ δόξα εἰς τοὺς αἰῶνας τῶν αἰώνων. Ἀμήν.

### St. Paul's First Letter to Timothy 1:12-17

Timothy, my son, I thank him who has given me strength for this, Christ Jesus our Lord, because he judged me faithful by appointing me to his service, though I formerly blasphemed and persecuted and insulted him; but I received mercy because I had acted ignorantly in unbelief, and the grace of our Lord overflowed for me with the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus. The saying is sure and worthy of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners. And I am the foremost of sinners; but I received mercy for this reason, that in me, as the foremost, Jesus Christ might display his perfect patience for an example to those who were to believe in him for eternal life. To the King of ages, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen.

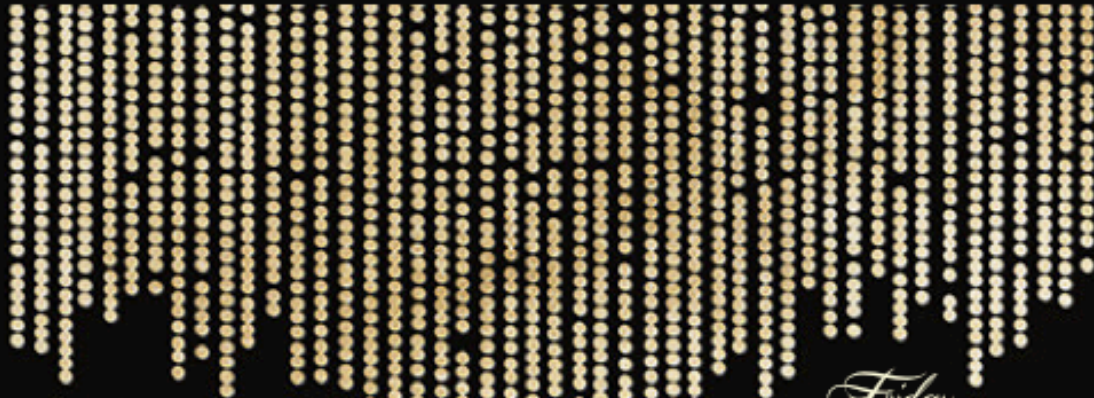
